ENTRY RAMP:

When the Center was built in 1949 not a lot of thought was given to the wheelchair users of the Center.



The concrete

floor of the Center was level with the front door concrete pad, a simple walk-through. When the wooden floor was installed the difference became over two inches. The Center now has a ramp that will allow our friends in wheelchairs to easily roll right on through the front door.

BINGO:

In August of 2003 the Center opened it's doors to the first of our monthly bingo games. Each year in August the Center offers something special to those who come and play bingo. From the very first night the community has enjoyed a fun filled evening, enjoying the friendship of friends and neighbors. This August was no different. 




